What is Musical Theater?

It is a unique art form that combines song, theatre and dance in a unique way, while expressing the characters emotions and develop the story. Musical Theater offers multiple benefits to students, such as:

1. It fosters **creativity, discipline** and **dedication**, so children can reach the desired levels of their artistic expression.
2. Encourages **collaboration, communication** and **teamwork**.
3. Through the playing of different roles, it allows children to look inside themselves and be more sensitive to those around them (**empathy**), It allows them to be more expressive and aware of daily circumstances.
4. It fosters **critical thinking** and shapes Good **morals and character**, as musical theater interprets the problems of the day to day issues and Topics.
5. It develops **concentration**, as it combines dance, theater and singing, thus improving the **coordination** of children.
6. It **entertains** through Theater play, music, dance and singing in a quality way, which makes children happy.

Trinity College London Exams
